

2017 Membership Application for Renewing Members

Garden Rules

1. Annual membership dues of \$50 are due in full by December 31st, 2016.
2. Checks for membership dues should be made payable to Henderson Park Community Garden and **mailed with your completed and signed Membership Agreement** (page 3) and your completed and signed Board of Directors Ballot (page 4) to:

3. **Each plot is rented for the period of January 1 through December 31.** Plots may be rented as they become available throughout the year. **Dues are pro-rated monthly for members renting a plot after August 1.**
4. A waiting list will be maintained for future plot availability.
5. **Each member may rent only one plot.** If plots become available during the year, and there are no names on the waiting list, these plots will be made available to the membership, at the standard rental rate as detailed in #1 and #3 above, with the understanding that the plots will be released for rental at the end of the year.
6. Plot-sharing arrangements are handled in the same way as individually rented plots at \$50 per plot. Each co-plot holder must complete and sign the Membership Agreement. Each plot has one vote in any issue put before the membership.
7. Prohibitions in the garden include:
 - a) Littering, dumping, alcohol consumption, and any other unlawful activities
 - b) Amplified sound
 - c) Ball playing or other forms of active recreation
 - d) Growing of illegal substances
 - e) Pets (with the exception of service animals)
 - f) Hoses (except by written permission)
 - g) Children under 12, unless accompanied and supervised by an adult
8. Only organic and natural means of disease and pest control may be used. The use of herbicides (weed killers), synthetic fertilizers, and synthetic pesticides in the garden is prohibited. Assistance in organic gardening methods will be provided to gardeners who request it.
9. Plot rentals are not transferable and fees are nonrefundable.

Member Commitments

10. **I agree to plant my plot within a reasonable period of time.** I will plant or otherwise tend my plot by May 1 (for renewing members). New members joining after May 1 have 14 days to plant their plots. If I haven't planted my plot by May 1 (or within 14 days of becoming a member), I understand that my plot may be reclaimed and reassigned.
11. **I will be responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of my plot as well as the paths around my plot.** I am responsible for watering, weeding, harvesting, mulching, and any other garden-related maintenance. When I cannot get to the garden to water my plot, I will arrange for another member to water it for me.
12. I recognize that water is a precious commodity and I will water my plot accordingly. I will use rainwater when available. I will restrict my usage of public water to no more than 30 minutes per day and I will do my best to water before 10:00 am and after 5:00 pm to reduce loss to evaporation. I will not use a hose or leave water running.
13. I will plant crops and decorate my plot in a manner that does not unreasonably encroach upon my neighbors' space, path, or access to sunlight.
14. If I cannot get to the garden to harvest from my plot, I will place one of the HPCG markers in my plot to indicate that food pantry volunteers and other members are welcome to pick from my plot.
15. I will harvest only from my plot unless granted permission by another member or posted markers indicate otherwise.
16. **I will not neglect my plot.** If I allow vegetables in my plot to continually rot (or become otherwise inedible), I will accept that garden members may harvest produce for the food pantry. We will put an HPCG marker in your plot until you return and remove it and store it in the shed.
17. **I agree to volunteer my time for general garden maintenance, to keep the garden site clean of weeds and debris, especially around my plot and along the garden pathways.** I understand that continued use of the site is contingent on our ability to maintain it. I may fulfill my commitment by participating in at least two (2) of our scheduled, quarterly workdays; and/or by volunteering on the food pantry and/or greenhouse team; and/or by completing chores from the chore list that will be posted on the kiosk (or in the shed).
18. **I will dispose of weeds in designated container(s), and plant materials in designated compost bins.**
19. I will keep garden gates closed and the toolshed locked.
20. I will show consideration toward fellow members, garden property, and the community at large.
